

PUBLIC NOTICE: TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES, GOVAN MBEKI ROAD

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate advises the public of temporary lane closures on Govan Mbeki Road, between the Duinefontein and Edward Makele Road (NY72) intersections.

This is in order to transport and install an abnormal load of concrete beams for a bridge at the intersection with Duinefontein Road, which will connect future MyCiTi bus services.

Work is scheduled between 08:00 and 17:00 from **14 March 2025 until the end of April 2025**.

- Both lanes serving traffic towards Gugulethu on Govan Mbeki Road will be closed. The two lanes serving traffic in the opposite direction will accommodate traffic in both directions.
- The left turning lane from Govan Mbeki Road into Duinefontein Road will be closed. All traffic will be accommodated using the other remaining lane.
- One lane will be closed on Duinefontein Road for traffic approaching the Govan Mbeki Road intersection. All traffic will be accommodated using the other remaining lane.

Please note that:

- Dates may change due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All road users should approach the area with caution and follow the safety signs in place.

The works will regrettably add to congestion in the short term. Motorists are advised to:

- Plan for longer journey times
- Make use of lift clubs, ride-sharing or public transport
- Avoid peak traffic times where possible

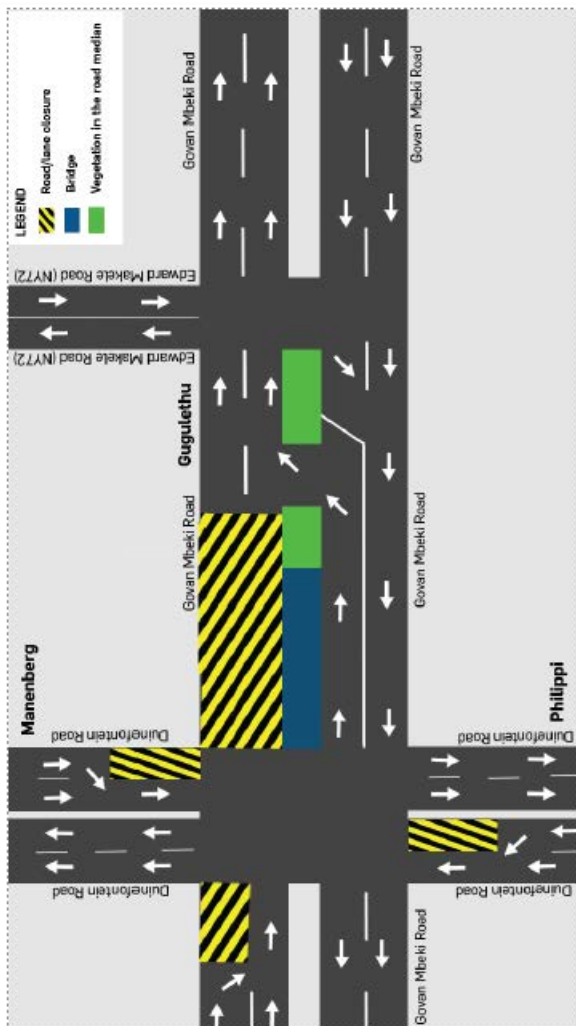
