

PUBLIC NOTICE: TEMPORARY LANE DIVERSION ALONG TURFHALL ROAD SEPTEMBER 2024 - SEPTEMBER 2025

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate advises the public of a temporary lane diversion to accommodate roadworks in the Lansdowne area as well as temporary road closures to accommodate construction.

Traffic will be affected on Turfhall Road between the M5 Kromboom Parkway and the intersection with Castor and Benona Roads from mid-September 2024 until September 2025.

- The two permanent lanes serving traffic toward the M5 Kromboom Parkway will be closed to traffic. Traffic will be diverted along two new lanes within the old median (centre) of the road. Two traffic lanes will be maintained in both directions.
- There will be temporary road closures at the intersections with Stockley Road, Pinehurst Road, Burwood Road, and Haroldene Road.
- A 4-way stop street will be in effect at the Civic and Woodbury Roads intersection.
- Temporary public transport stops will be placed along the reconfigured road for passengers to use during construction.
- Temporary walkways and pedestrian crossings with signage will help people navigate safely on foot and avoid the construction area.
- The traffic switch will take place in phases over approximately two weeks.

The planned work will add to journey times and motorists are urged to plan their travel in advance, factor in extra travel time and follow the signage and flag personnel that have been deployed to keep traffic moving safely.

Please note that the abovementioned dates may change due to unforeseen circumstances.

The City thanks residents for their patience, support, and understanding while we undertake this necessary work to deliver safe and reliable public transport services, help reduce congestion, and uplift surrounding areas well into the future.

PUBLIC NOTICE: PERMANENT ROAD CLOSURES, TURFHALL ROAD SEPTEMBER 2024

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate advises the public of permanent road closures being implemented from September 2024 along Turfhall Road, between the M5 Kromboom Parkway and the intersection of Castor and Benona Roads.

This follows a public participation process from 17 May to 25 June 2021 and approval by Council on 24 February 2022.

Please also see overleaf for temporary changes to traffic flow while work is underway.

Permanent partial road closures

1. Median road closure at Prince Arthur Road

Prince Arthur Road will become a left-in, left-out only. Right turning will not be possible between Turfhall Road and Prince Arthur Road

2. Block Road

Block Road and Waterloo Road will no longer link. Block Road will be split into two roads that end in cul de sacs.

Permanent full road closures

1. Lansdowne Road (between St. Kilda Road and Taronga Road)

No direct access between St Kilda and Taronga roads. Alternate access to Turfhall Road via Rouxton Crescent, Flamingo Crescent, and Flamingo Road

2. Turfhall Road (intersection with Haywood Road)

No direct access between Turfhall Road and the northern leg of the intersection with Lansdowne Road. Alternate access available via Rouxton Crescent or via Hay Road and Benona Road which will benefit from a new signalised intersection with Turfhall Road.
